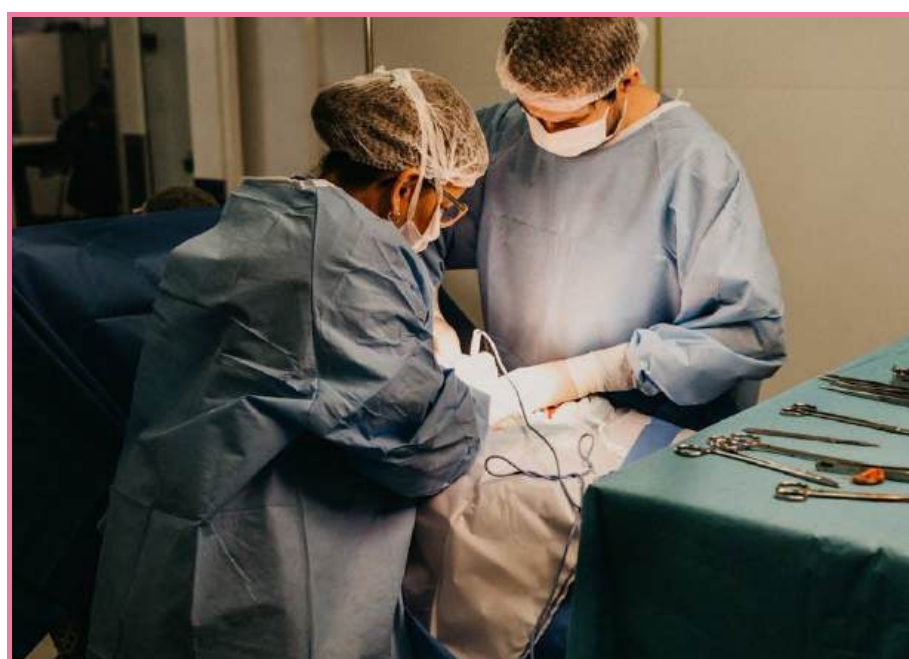


Hidden Costs of Cosmetic Tourism
